## Letter from our Executive Director

**The year 2019** was one full of excitement and accomplishments for Dress for Success Cincinnati. We instituted and began execution of a transformative strategic plan. Our largest and most important fund-raising event, The Fashion Show, raised a record-breaking \$292,000. We restructured our major client programs for more efficiency and effectiveness. With the unexpected sale of our building, our special task force identified an even better, more convenient location for our staff and our clients. And we ended the year with our sound financial footing stronger than ever.

And then ...

The international pandemic changed the world, including our world, impacting all of us, our families and our work. Our first and foremost concerns were the health and well being of our staff, clients, volunteers, and community. The challenges were (and are) especially brutal for the women we serve, many of whom are the most economically vulnerable.

But even while our offices were forced to close, our virtual doors have remained open! We have wanted our clients to know that we are always here for them. We increased virtual and remote support for our clients, including:

- A Participant Facebook Group updated daily for access to online programs including access to Accenture's online Skills to Succeed series of courses, and our own live discussion group, Topic Tuesday, to review Skills to Succeed
- One-on-one career coaching, mock interviews and resume reviews by phone
- A resources page that includes helpful services and current job postings
- Weekly virtual meet-ups for our Professional Women's Group (PWG) giving our clients continued community and connection while isolated
- A new no-contact Style Kit pickup service to ensure women have the clothing and accessories they need to begin to get their careers back on track

Even though our office, Donation Center and Portaluca were closed temporarily, we worked to make sure we helped women through this time of high unemployment and economic distress.


No one knows exactly what our community will look like in the future. Yet we do know that ***the women we serve will need us more than ever.***

## Dress for Success Cincinnati enters an exciting new partnership.

In April 2019, DfSC entered a partnership agreement with Cincinnati Works to leverage both organizations' strengths to best serve our clients, while minimizing duplication of services and making the most efficient use of community resources. Cincinnati Works is an expert in the area of individual coaching, and DfSC provides an environment, group programs and networks in which women clients thrive.

Cincinnati Works now provides all of DfSC's workforce development programs on-site at DfSC through a dedicated joint employee. We are working together to integrate the best of both agencies' workforce development program curricula, and DfSC clients have access to additional on-site opportunities, such as financial and behavioral coaching.

## **We have rebranded, relaunched and restructured our client programs.**

- HigherHER, our new 4-week career development program developed together with Cincinnati Works, is now shorter and more interactive. HigherHER includes monthly employer panels and mock interviews with our corporate partners. Referral partners can refer women directly to employer panels and mock interviews, however, without going through the StyleHER suiting program first.
- StyleHER (formerly Suiting) is no longer just about suits! We're offering more options for interview and employment attire to reflect current employment attire trends across diverse industries. As always, it's not just about the clothes—it's really about the confidence that a woman gains when she is happy with how she looks and feels.

### **These client programs also continue to help women earn financial stability:**

#### ***Professional Women's Group***

We continue to offer the signature Dress for Success PWG, which provides professional development and a network of support for employed women. PWG includes a newly formed task force and special events coordinated by members.

#### ***Career Center – Technology + Personal Coaching***

Many of our clients have no access to the Internet and computers. Our Career Center, in partnership with Cincinnati Works, provides technology tools and one-on-one coaching.

#### ***Taking Dress for Success on the Road***

Dress for Success Cincinnati goes where the need is and to women who cannot always reach us. Our Mobile Career Transformation Center allows us to take StyleHER and a special one-hour version of our HigherHER program to women across 12 counties in the Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky region.



## One Woman's Story

**What do you do when you've been downsized after 21 years of working?** That's what happened to Tracy. After being downsized, for several years Tracy "settled" for jobs beneath her abilities. Finally, she'd had enough of being underemployed. Through our new partnership with Cincinnati Works, Tracy connected with Dress for Success Cincinnati, and received an interview suit to look for a new job she deserved.

She's now employed by Christ Hospital and is a member of our Professional Women's Group, where she can learn from her peers and expert speakers who discuss career advancement and life skills topics. She also participated in our Mock Interview program to get feedback from professionals.

The network of support and camaraderie gave Tracy new ways to market herself to potential employers and had reduced Tracy's anxieties about being "out there" again.

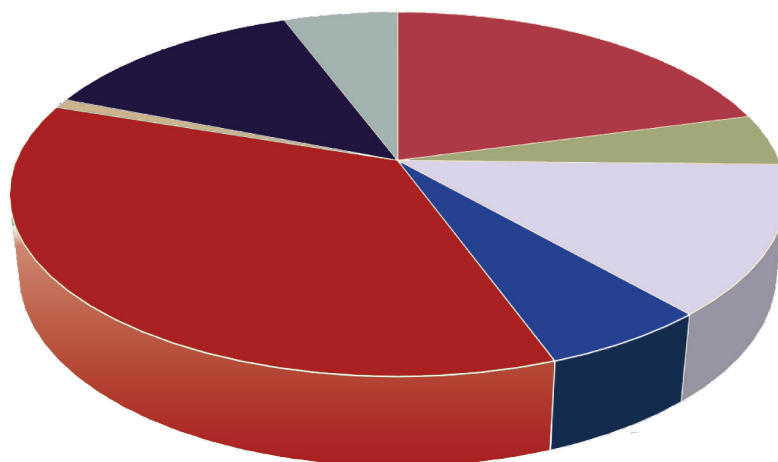

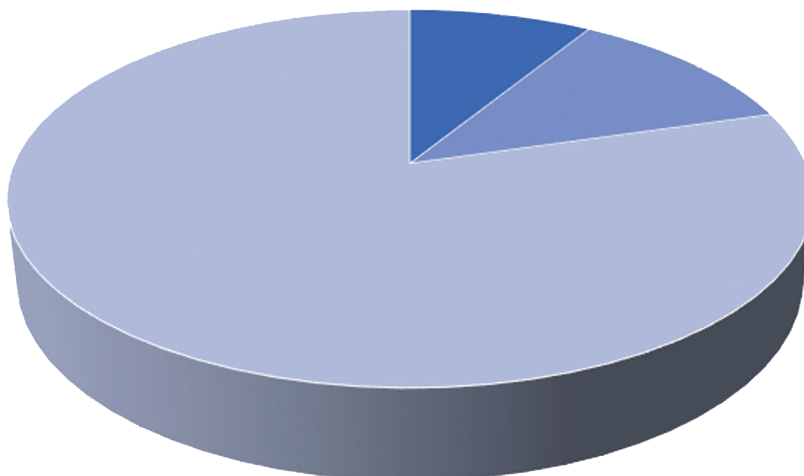

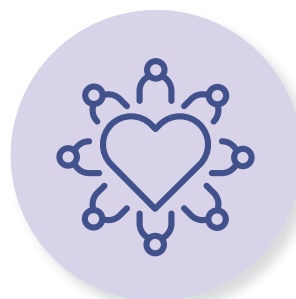
